**Application Process**

1. Please write a 600 - 700 word personal statement (in a Word file) that describes why you are applying for the THSH Taiwan Studies Scholarship - describe your interest in Taiwan, how this interest fits into your academic and/or career plans, and how the scholarship would be important to you. Include this application cover page and your personal statement in an email to taiwanstudy@houston-taiwanese.org.
2. Two recommendations are required. These may be from a teacher, employer, or someone else who can speak to your promise as a scholarship recipient. Please submit reference directly to taiwanstudy@houston-taiwanese.org.
3. The recipient is required to provide a 5 minutes report to the audience attending THSH annual fundraiser (November 11) at Houston Taiwanese Community Center and to promote community support of the scholarship.
4. Upon completion of the course, recipient will provide a 15 to 30-minute presentation to the THSH committee/membership that summarizes what was learned and how this related to the recipient's interests, academics, and /or career development and future plans.
